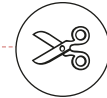

REGISTER BY MAIL: Send a check payable to Richmond Art Center for the amount due and include class number and daytime phone number.

REGISTER BY PHONE: Use your Visa, MasterCard, or American Express. **IN PERSON:** Tuesday through Saturday 1-5 pm.

Your check or credit card payment is your confirmation. Space cannot be reserved until tuition is received.

For all classes and workshops, it is best to register one week in advance of the start date. This advance registration helps us to secure an accurate count of those interested in participating, allowing us to know if we have our required minimum enrollment to run the class/workshop.

Richmond residents are eligible for a 5% discount on all classes and workshops. EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT Register two weeks before classes begin and receive a 5% discount.

ATTENTION PARENTS

Teens 16 and older may also enroll in adult classes. Children are encouraged to "dress for mess" for art classes.

Security rules require that you come into the Art Center to drop off and pick up your child.

PLEASE NOTE

Adult fees do not cover tool or supply costs unless otherwise indicated. Children's class fees include all supplies. While encouraging student involvement in the arts, RAC facilities are not intended to substitute for a craftsman's studio to produce commercial work for sale. Lectures or demonstrations will not be repeated in case of student tardiness or absence. Students must enter at the rear studio entrance on 25th Street. Doors will be locked at 8:00 pm during evening classes.

REFUND AND CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY (effective Sept. 8, 2009)

If you are unable to attend a class, we will issue a full refund if you notify us a minimum of two weeks before the first class. If notification of withdrawal is given after this time but at least five business days before class begins, you will receive a refund of the class fee less a \$15 fee. Three weeks into a class, registrations are considered final and no refunds will be given. Exceptions to this policy may be granted in cases of documented family or medical emergency. Fees cannot be prorated due to planned absences, minor illnesses or vacation schedules. No refunds are given due to failure to attend class. If enrollment is insufficient and RAC cancels a class, you fee will be refunded in full.

NEW CREDIT POLICY

RAC no longer issues credits for dropped or cancelled classes. We will issue refunds.

STUDENT CONDUCT

The RAC's mission is to provide the public with a positive, creative experience. It is every participant's responsibility to be friendly, helpful, and courteous at all times. Consequently, the following are not allowed: uncooperative or disrespectful behavior toward an instructor, student, staff member or RAC visitor; improper physical interaction or verbal address of others; behavior creating a hazard to persons, personal property, or RAC property; possession or use of drugs or alcohol; intoxicated or drugged state of behavior; possession of weapons.

For the RAC to fulfill its goal of providing a positive educational environment, all students should immediately inform their instructor, or education staff, of any situation that hinders their learning experience. If a student engages in inappropriate behavior, a review by the Education Director will determine the student's standing. An instructor or staff member may ask a student to leave the premises pending review if inappropriate behavior warrants such action. If a student is asked to leave, a continued presence constitutes trespassing.
